The main event dedicated to the documentary culture in Latin America, **It's All True – 22nd International Documentary Film Festival** announced this Saturday, April 29th, 2017, the winners of this year's edition.

The international jury was formed by director Alexandre O. Philippe; documentary filmmaker Anne Georget; and film producer Jennifer Walton. The Brazilian jury was formed by film producer Daniela Capelato; cinematographer Jacques Cheuiche; and director Joel Zito Araújo.

For the third time, the winners of both Brazilian and International Short Film Competitions are automatically qualified to be considered by the Academy of Motion Pictures Arts and Sciences in Hollywood to compete for the Oscar for Best Documentary (Short Subject). **It's All True** is the first and sole Latin American festival to be granted this status.
