# 30th IT'S ALL TRUE ANNOUNCES PARALLEL PROGRAMING

30th Anniversary Special! Encounters and in-person masterclasses from April 6 to 13. Streaming screenings available from April 14 to 30 on the Itaú Cultural Play platform.

**It's All True** celebrates three decades of annual activities through a special program featuring landmark films from its history and discussions about its cultural impact.

This program includes the **30th Anniversary Special Encounters!** series, presented in partnership with SESC-SP's Centro de Pesquisa e Formação. The event brings together four acclaimed filmmakers honored throughout the festival's thirty-year history: **Eliza Capai, Joel Zito Araújo, Paulo Sacramento,** and **Roberto Berliner**. These artists, who navigate between cinema and reality while expanding the boundaries of Brazilian documentary, will lead discussions on **April 10 and 11**.

A staple of It's All True's program, the **Spcine Training** initiative invites leading figures of Brazilian cinema for two masterclasses on **April 6 and 13**, featuring guests **Susanna Lira** and **Luiz Bolognesi**.

Closing the celebrations, an **exclusive selection of ten short films** will be available on the free streaming platform **Itaú Cultural Play** from **April 14 to 30**. Curated by It's All True founder and director Amir Labaki, the showcase features six titles from the 2025 Brazilian National Short Film Competition and four classic short films by Vladimir Carvalho, honored in this edition's retrospective.

### 6pm – Joel Zito Araújo

Director, screenwriter and producer renowned for exploring Black identity in Brazilian society. Author of the book and film Denying Brazil, It's All True 2001 winner, and My Friend Fela (2019), awarded Best Diaspora Film at Fespaco/Burkina Faso, Special Jury Prize at It's All True 2019 and Best Doc at the Pan African 2020 USA. Daughters of the Wind (2005) won 8 Kikitos at Gramado.

#### 7:30pm - Paulo Sacramento

Paulo Sacramento is a filmmaker who directed the feature films The Prisoner of the Iron Bars, winner of Best Documentary at It's All True 2023, Riocorrente (2013), and The Eye and the Knife (2018). A producer, editor, and curator, he has restored works by renowned Brazilian filmmakers such as Jairo Ferreira, Aloysio Raulino, José Agrippino de Paula, and José Mojica Marins.

#### April 11

#### 6pm – Roberto Berliner

Roberto Berliner, a journalist who graduated from UFRJ, began his career in the late 70s. He directed the fiction feature Nise: The Heart of Madness (2016), which drew 150,000 viewers to theaters and won over 20 awards, and the documentary Os Quatro, selected for It's All True 2020. His other works include A Farra do Circo (2014), Herbert de Perto (2009), Pindorama (2008), and A Pessoa é para o que Nasce (2003).

#### 7:30pm - Eliza Capai

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Eliza Capai premiered her fourth feature, Incompatible with Life, at It's All True 2023, where it won Best Film and was pre-qualified for an Academy Award. She directed Brazil's first true crime series, Elize Matsunaga: Once Upon a Crime (2020, Netflix), and has won numerous awards for Your Turn (2019), The Tortoise and the Tapir (2016), the short film Severinas (2014), and Here is So Far (2013).
