São Paulo, March 20th, 2024 – The founding director of It's All True – International Documentary Film Festival, Amir Labaki, presented the program of the 29th edition of the festival in a press conference at the Itaú Cultural in São Paulo. It's All True 2024 takes place between April 3 and 14 in São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro simultaneously, with free admission. The festival's itinerant program will return this year, taking this edition to Belo Horizonte (MG), in partnership with the Vale Cultural Institute; more information will be released soon.

It's All True 2024 will screen a total of 77 feature, medium-length and short films from 34 countries. On April 3, the festival's opening session for guests in Rio de Janeiro will feature the world premiere of "Um Filme para Beatrice", by Helena Solberg, at Estação NET Botafogo. Not yet seen in Latin America, British documentary The Contestant (2023) by Clair Tiley will be screened at the opening session for guests in São Paulo on April 4 at the Cinemateca Brazileira.

The 29th edition of It's All True – International Documentary Film Festival has been majorly sponsored by VALE CULTURAL INSTITUTE, sponsored by Itaú and by DESENVOLVE SP, made in partnership with SESC-SP, had cultural support from GALO DA MANHÃ, SPCINE and ITAÚ CULTURAL. Produced by the São Paulo State Office of Cultural Affairs and the Federal Government's Ministry of Culture through the Culture Incentive Law (Law # 8313).

"There is much to celebrate in such a vibrant crop of documentaries as the one we have the privilege of releasing in the country in this 29th edition," celebrates the

founding director of It's All True, Amir Labaki. "It's an exceptionally intense director of the power of cinema". "It's an exceptionally intense documentários affirmation of the power of cinema".

This year, the São Paulo exhibition circuit will be the Espaço Itaú de Cinema - Augusta, Cinemateca Brazileira, Sesc 24 de Maio, Instituto Moreira Salles and Centro Cultural São Paulo. In Rio de Janeiro, the screenings will be held at the Estação NET Botafogo and in two theaters of the Estação NET Rio.

The It's All True 2024 program includes the Competitive Showcases of Brazilian and International Feature Films and Brazilian and International Short Films and the Non-Competitive Showcases: Special Programs, The State of Things, Latin American Showcase, It's All True Classics and Retrospectives.

The films awarded jury prizes in the Brazilian and International Feature/Medium-Length and Short Film Competitions will automatically qualify for consideration for next year's Academy Awards. This year's awards ceremony will take place on Saturday, April 13, at the Cinemateca Brasileira in São Paulo. The films awarded by the official juries will be re-screened in both Rio and São Paulo.

The festival also includes several training and education activities: the 21st International Documentary Conference, presented in partnership with the Cinemateca Brasileira; the lecture series From an Idea to the Screen, presented in partnership with the São Paulo State Office of Cultural Affairs and Desenvolve SP; the seminar Documentary Writing, at the Centro de Pesquisa e Formação of Sesc/SP; and the Spcine Development Invites: It's All True (date to be announced).

The It's All True 2024 Retrospectives celebrate Brazilian photographer and filmmaker Thomaz Farkas (1924-2011) in his centennial, and British director and essayist Mark Cousins, who is visiting Brazil for the first time.

As part of the official Viva Farkas event celebration, the festival will exhibit four documentaries directed (in one case, co-directed) by Farkas and two films directed by Lauro Escorel and Walter Lima Jr. Farkas' work will also be the topic of one of the 21st International Documentary Conference encounters.

On April 9, the Conference will open with a Masterclasss by Mark Cousins who, on the 11th, will also take part in a debate in Rio de Janeiro. The Cousins retrospective highlights eight documentaries in his prolific career, including his most recent film, "Cinema Has Been My True Love: The Work and Times of Lynda Myles", released last year at the Telluride Film Festival.

In the 29th edition of the festival, the It's All True Classics program highlights two other events: American documentary filmmaker Robert Drew's (1924-2014) centennial and the 50th anniversary of the Carnation Revolution in Portugal.
